Originating out of Daytona Beach, the meet/tour will visit local attractions, restaurants and private car collections. More details coming.

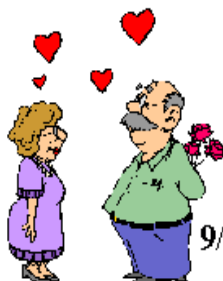
