Oil change; a follow-up

The November 2009 newsletter contained a warning from Jack Horvath stating that at recent oil change the shop had installed 5W30 oil in his 50 Buick. Weight engines of that time were not designed for. We recently received a note from one of our newer members, Terry Page, stating that the same problem can happen with newer cars also. Here is Terry's response:

You need to watch the dealerships also. I bought a new vehicle a few years back and as I always have done I would go back to them for service during the warranty period. This included the oil changes. During the second trip to this dealer I noticed that the sticker that is placed in the windshield had 10W30 indicated, so I turned around and went back to inquire about the change, since I had read the manual and the factory said to use only 5W20. The explanation from the dealer was that they bought the 10W30 in bulk but the 5W20 was only in quart (costs them more money). They ended up changing the oil again to 5W20. From that point on I buy my own oil and they put it in.

Did you know
