Window Lift Motor Replacement

I DROVE MY '92 RIVIERA TO THE GEORGIA ROA / DIXIE CHAPTER BOA MEETING ON SAT. DUE TO OTHER COMMITMENTS, I COULDN'T STAY FOR LUNCH (MY LOSS). ON THE WAY HOME I TRIED TO ROLL UP MY WINDOW. IT WENT UP ABOUT 6" THEN ONLY THE GNASHING OF GEARS. IT WOULD GO UP AND DOWN BUT ONLY THE 6" OR SO.

HAVING REPLACED THE DOOR LATCH ON MY WIFE'S '90 REATTA, I AM SOMEWHAT FA-MILIAR WITH THE INNER WORK-INGS OF AN "E" BODY DOOR. THE WINDOW LIFT MOTOR AND ARM ARE RIVETED TO THE DOOR WITH 1/4" ALUMIN-MUM RIVETS WITH A HARDENED STEEL SHANK. THE MANUAL SAYS DRILL THE RIVETS OUT (EASIER SAID THAN DONE) AND REPLACE WITH 1/4" RIVETS.

ONE PROBLEM IS THAT POP RIVETS (THAT MOST OF US BACKYARD MECHANICS USE) ONLY GO UP TO 3/16", THE OTHER PROBLEM WAS WHERE TO GET A REPLACEMENT MO-TOR.

THE MOTOR WAS READILY AVAILABLE AT O'RIELLYS (P/N 82-144). SIMPLY DRILL A HOLE TO LOCK THE SPRING LOADED ARM, DRILL OUT MORE RIVETS AND REATTACH ARM AND MOUNTING BRACKET TO MOTOR WITH BOLTS AND NUTS PROVIDED WITH MOTOR.

THE ¼" RIVET PROBLEM WAS SOLVED BY SUPER GLUE-ING (WASHER STYLE) NUTS TO THE BACK OF THE ASSEMBLY (CK ALIGNMENT WITH HOLES), CUTTING ¼" BOLTS SHORT ENOUGH TO FULLY ENGAGE THE NUT BUT NOT HIT THE MOVING LIFT ARM, ASSEMBLE USING "LOCKTITE" ON THE SHORT BOLTS. A LITTLE LUBE ON THE

LIFT ROLLER AND THE WINDOW OPERATES PERFECTLY. (COST UNDER \$40.00)

PS-WHILE IN THE DOOR PANEL I CHECKED AND RE-PLACED MY 5" RADIO SPEAKER, IT WAS TOAST.

YES, I KNOW TO DO BOTH SPEAKERS AS A SET (MAYBE NEXT WEEKEND)


