Ethanol to go to 15% By: Cliff Dillingham

In October I received a publication from SEMA (Specialty Equipment Marketing Association), a trade organization associated with after-market specialty automotive products, stating that the EPA was considering raising the ethanol content in gasoline from 10 percent (E10) to 15 percent (E15) for late-model They thanked the hundreds of members who asked President Obama to stop the EPA from raising the Ethanol content. Their opposition is "due to the concerns that the additional content will harm automobiles of all ages, including special interest collectors and historic vehicles. They stated Ethanol increases water formation in the fuel system, especially when the vehicle sits over a period of time. Also, under these conditions, formic acid is created which corrodes metals, plastics and rubber. They also

said Ethanol also causes engines to burn hotter which could lead to premature engine and equipment failure. Although the higher Ethanol content gasoline is intended for newer vehicles only no information is currently available covering the distribution and regulation to make sure it is not dispensed in older vehicles, and hundreds of millions of boats, chainsaws, leaf blowers, lawn mowers, all-terrain vehicles and the like.

Since that time, the EPA has now approved E-15. Enter the following Web link into your Browser and read the October 13, *USA Today* article describing some of the foreseen problems.


The 2011 Buick Regal stands as shining evidence of that effort.
