COOKIES - 1/2 cup Butter, 3/4 cup Brown Sugar, 1 cup Sugar, 1 Egg, 1/4 Tsp. Baking Soda, 1/2 Tsp Salt, 3 cups Flour, 1/4 cup Milk. 2 cups Halved Cranberries, 1/2 cups Nuts (optional).

FROSTING - 1/2 cup Butter, browned (heat until butter turns brown), 1/4 tsp Vanilla, 3 Tbls Light Cream, 2 cups Powdered Sugar.

Cook ie: Cream butter, sugars & egg. Add baking soda, salt, flour & milk. Mix well and stir in cranberries & nuts. Bake at 350 degrees for 12 to 15 minutes.

Frosting: Combine all ingredients and frost cookies
