The $35^{\text {th }}$ Annual Peach Blossom BOP\&C was held On April $30^{\text {th }}$ and began with a meet-and-greet at the Cherokee Cattle Company in Marietta hosted on Friday night by our friends at the Southeastern GTO Association (SEGTOA). This turned out to be a fun opportunity both for out of towners and locals to get together for cars and camaraderie prior to the big day.
This year's show was held at Piedmont Church in Marietta. For those who have never been there, the church hosts a yearlong $1^{\text {st }}$ Saturday of the month morning car cruise-in. They routinely draw dozens of cars that park in front of the church along Piedmont Rd. that will come and go over the course of the 3 -hour cruise-in. The BOPC show field was in the rear parking lot which can provide parking for over 250 cars. Total show registration was 135 cars including 55 day of show registrations.
