Consumer Reports Recommends the 2017 LaCrosse

In recent issue of Consumer reports, the magazine gave the 2017 Buick LaCrosse its recommended rating and found it out performed several other premium luxury cars priced \$12,000 to \$26,000 dollars higher than the Buick test model's \$43,225 price tag. The magazine noted that LaCrosse's 2017 redesign produced a lighter, lower, and wider car than its predecessor. The weight savings couples with the new eight-speed automatic afford improved fuel economy, 24 mpg overall. Consumer Reports also noted the availability of all-wheel drive, at the expense of 1 or 2 miles per gallon.

They described the cabin as being "library quiet" and its handling as secure with ample power to be confident during freeway merge situations. The Cabin is well finished with ample room in the back seat, but reviewers did note that the new rakish roofline could make getting in and out of the car a challenge for some. Thick roof pillars and a high rear shelf compromise visibility, but the instruments and infotainment system (not just a radio any more .Ed.) are "uncluttered and intuitive", respectfully.

They also took issue with the LaCrosse's electronic gear selector, saying that it could accidentally be left in neutral when trying to shift into reverse and they chided Buick for placing advanced safety features, like forward collision control in the top trim level, only,

However, LaCrosse was the highest scoring American car, scoring an 85 out of 100 on their road test, fifth behind Infinity Q70, Lexus GS 350, Audi A 6 Quattro, and Genesis G80 and ahead of Cadillac XTS Premium. Lincoln Continental Premium, and Mercedes Benz E300 4Matic.

Consumer Reports summarized the 2017 LaCrosse as "Well mannered," and that it "delivers comfort, space, and a quality ride with a stylish new silhouette.
