We had a great time in August at a Pigeon Forge, TN, reunion, with about a hundred truckers and guntruckers and their families. We were again able to take USO snacks for our hospitality room with our 76 Buick.

Our Transportation Truck Group was the first unit to build these guntrucks using 60 of our 720 cargo trucks. This took place after the first enemy ambush on 2 Sep 1967 killed nine truckers and other soldiers. It was clear that over our 110 mile mountainous route we needed to protect ourselves. During the next five years, about 300 of these guntrucks were built by many units throughout Vietnam.




