



The Blitz is the insignia for Opel. General Motors owned Adam Opel AG of Germany from 1929 until selling the division to PSC of France in 2017. GM marketed Opels through their network of Buick dealers from the 1950s through the mid 1970s. Buick then offered Japanese built Isuzus, rebadged as Opels into the early 1980s. Even though GM no longer owns Opel, the current Buick Cascada and Regal models are based on the Opel Cascada and Insignia.
