
Being one of the founders and early chapter directors of the Buick Town Chapter (Flint) led to his planning & organization of first the annual event we call the BCA National Meet. That first meet in 1971 and subsequent meets through 1976 were all held in Flint at the location of the Buick Motor Division with Joe being the show chairman each year.

It was through Joe's endorsement and support that made possible the "rotation" of the National Meets beginning in 1977 with the first National outside of Flint held in Strongsville, Ohio, hosted by the N.E. Ohio Chapter, (at the very same hotel as this year's event). The Lord only knows how many more years it might have been before such a move might have occurred without that endorsement.

Although Joe owned many beautiful Buicks through the years, he was more about driving (touring) and yes, racing them than winning "awards". It was this desire that led to his being one of the co-founders and organizers of the Buick Driving Enthusiasts (BDE).

I know I could write a book (or certainly a short story) about "my hero" Joseph Francis Taubitz and his contributions to the hobby, and in particular to the Buick Club of America, with just things I've been privileged to have been a part of. I am proud to say I knew and associated with THE "good ole Joe". He was a great American & good friend. May he rest in peace.




