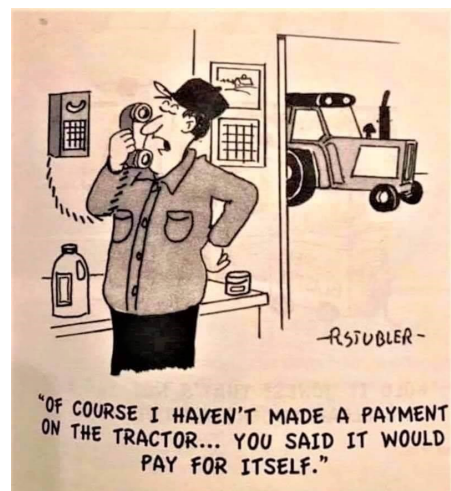

Message from SEGTOA concerning the 39th Annual Peach Blossom BOPC

Good morning SEGTOA, I hope this message finds you healthy and well. It is my hope that as our communities continue to Contain and work toward Mitigating the spread of COVID-19 through Social distancing (Isolation), it is our hope that we will have a "2020 BOPC."

Over the past week or so, I telephonically contacted Mr. Scott Edwards (Piedmont Church Rep) relative to extra-church activities (monthly Cruise-in and BOPC Car Show). Mr. Edwards informed me that he would obtain guidance from church officials relative to whether extra-church activities would be suspended. I am awaiting feedback from Mr. Edwards on that subject. As you are aware, School, Church and Business activities across the State has been temporality suspended due to Social-distancing practices. Piedmont church is following the practice and has suspended church gatherings as per Federal (CDC), Local and State governments requests to protect against COVID-19 spread; there are no time constraints as to how long this practice will remain in effect.

I have been telephonically contacted, emailed and texted messaged from SEGTOA members, our BOPC committee leaders and one other club president (Cadillac). There has been expressed concern for the well-being and safety of our memberships. We want to have a successful 2020 BOPC but only when it is deemed safe to do so. As I write this memo, I have received no cancelation notices from the church. Therefore, the BOPC remains "scheduled" May 15-16, as we continue to monitor disease escalation or de-escalation rates in our area.

Last week, I contacted our BOPC committee representative for Awards and T-shirts. I also had discussion with other SEGTOA leaders pertaining to preservation of BOPC resources. As a result of those discussions, the design of the awards and t-shirts were entering into final approval stages. I have asked that production of the awards be place on a brief hold until we have more information on potential postponement. In the interim, we have decided to remove fixed-dates from the awards, dash plaques, koozies and t-shirts and will reference the BOPC as "39th Annual Peach Blossom 2020." This was accomplished to ensure quality of product at the time of show/presentation.

I hope that you have had time to rest and enjoy the outdoors as we push through these uncertain times. I would suggest, calling an old friend, reading books, catching up on Legends periodicals, writing tech articles for Tiger Tales, ordering parts, and taking care of all the Honey Dos! We will get through this Pandemic and I pray that you and your family remain healthy.

When I receive more information from the church and we learn more from our local authorities, I will provide periodic updates. You may continue to pre-register for BOPC.
