Take Exit 216, At the bottom of the ramp, turn left. A left turn is correct for both travelers from the North and South.


Travel East on Hwy 155 to the intersection with Highway 23/42 1.5 Miles

Proceed straight through the intersection and travel Highway 155 to intersection with Racetrack Road. 0.4 Miles

Proceed straight through the intersection with Racetrack Road. (Highway 155 becomes South Zack Hinton Parkway.) Continue to intersection with Key's Ferry Road. 1.0 Mile

Turn Right on Key's Ferry Road and continue until intersection with Lake Dow Road. 1.1 miles
Turn Left on Lake Dow Road and left again after the McDonalds into Heritage Park


