Some cars never leave you. Even though it may have been twenty, thirty, forty or more years since you had last seen it. It may have been your car, or belonged to your parents, grand parents, a favorite uncle or cousin. Or a chance encounter on the street. It could have been a car you saw and rode in every day Or just one memorable ride for the ages. A car that in the back of your mind you vow you will one day own and relive the dream.

For me, I guess I have always been partial to Buicks. Could be hereditary. My Grandfather switched to Buick from Hudson because he did not like the step-down models. My Dad followed suite and from 1950 on drove Buicks exclusively.

My first ride in a Buick was coming home from the hospital in a 1955 Century Riviera. I have no memory of that car, other than pictures and home movies. It gave way to a cranberry red 1963 Special Deluxe wagon, that I remember clearly. It faithfully served us for about six years.

Dad was never one to purchase anything on impulse, but I remember sitting at a stop sign in Spring of 1969 when an auto transport carrying new Buicks went by on its way to the local dealership. Up top, center was a sky blue 1969 Sportwagon with wood grain siding. Dad blurted out . "That is my next car!" And sure enough, by the weekend it was in our driveway.

With its skylight roof and third seat, that car became a favorite for my siblings and me. It served the family through seven New England Winters and eight Summers on Cape Cod, numerous camping trips, as well as a cross country drive to Colorado. Faithful till the end. And the end, unfortunately came at the hands of a hit and run driver who took out the left side of the Sportwagon. The insurance company repaired it, but it was never the same. Dad traded it in shortly thereafter for a preowned 1973 Estate Wagon. That was the car I drove through high school. And will likely be the topic of another story.

Back to the Sportwagon. I have been searching high and low for another car like it for many years. It is amazing how many of them have been "upgraded" with GS hoods and badging, 455s and bucket seats, To each his own, I guess.

But, not too long ago while plugging "Buick Sportwagon" into the search bar on Ebay, I found something to tide me over for a while: A 1/43 scale model by Italian diecast maker Kess of a 1969 Sportwagon identical to Dad's. Yes, light blue, three seat. With the wood grain. Buy it now was clicked without hesitation and it now has an honored spot on my desk.

Yes, cars come and cars go. Some are merely appliances, meant to get us from point a to point b. Others are special, they stand out and are part of our history. I guess that is one of the reasons that we join a car club. To share those memories with others that understand.


