



BUICK TRIVIA ANSWER



The Ventiports first appeared in the 1949 model year. Legend has it that Buick stylist Ned Nickles designed and installed a set of round fender vents on his personal 1948 Roadmaster. As the story goes, Nickles incorporated small electric lamps wired to the ignition system so they would flash in sequence with the engine's firing order. Reportedly, he was inspired by the flashing exhaust pipes on World War II fighter aircraft.

Buick general manager Harlow Curtice fell in love with it and ordered the Ventiports into production on the 1949 models, a scant seven months away—but minus the flashing lamps. A legend was born!
