





Hop aboard the town's most iconic resident "Milly the Trolley" for a fully narrated tour of Milledgeville's historic district! Featuring grand architecture, beautiful squares and historic neighborhoods, the sixty minute tour provides an overview of Milledgeville's history during its sixty-eight year period as the capital city of Georgia. During the course of the tour, guests will also be escorted on a guided walk through the former statehouse square and St. Stephens Episcopal Church, consecrated in 1843.

Please note, the trolley is ADA compliant but moderate mobility is recommended for those who wish to disembark at the statehouse square and St. Stephens Episcopal Church

# Georgia's Old Governor's Mansion



Completed in 1839, Georgia's Old Governor's Mansion is one of the finest examples of High Greek Revival architecture in the nation. Serving as the residence for Georgia's chief executives for over thirty years, the Mansion's history encompasses the antebellum, Civil War, and early Reconstruction phases of the state's history.

The Mansion is fully ADA compliant.
