



# 2024 Peach Blossom BOPC

The Southeastern GTO Association (SEGTOA) hosted the 43rd annual Peach Blossom BOPC car show at Piedmont Church in Marietta on Saturday May 4, 2024. In all, on a potentially rainy day 102 of Detroit and GM's finest were on display: 71 Pontiacs, 16 Buicks, 13 Cadillacs and 3 Oldsmobiles. SEGTOA treated attendees with a display of every GTO model produced from 1964 to 1974 to celebrate the 60th anniversary of that fabled muscle car. There was a great BBQ lunch and entertaining DJ music to round out the day.

The Dixie Chapter BCA was well represented in the Buick field and brought home a great number of plaques and awards. Jerry and Jean Richstein placed first in 1948 or older with their 1934 Buick. J.D. Westfall took a first place with his 1971 Riviera in the E Body class 1970-79. Howard ad Sylvia Baker brought home a second place award with their Reatta in the two seater class. Danny Finkelstein took first in 1968-72 A body, open with his 1968 GS 400 Convertible. Bruce and Shar Kile got first place in 1968-72 A body, closed models with their 1970 Skylark hardtop. Tom Lynde took a second place in 1990 and up miscellaneous with a 1990 Park Avenue sedan. Dixie Chapter member Alan Zigler took first, E body 1962-1969 with his Grand Prix. And finally, Dixie Chapter member Jerry Wilson earned best Buick with his 1972 GS 455 Stage 1.




