

BUICK TRIVIA





Southern Belle, our 1979 Buick Limited Estate Wagon seats get a new life

After trying several different kinds and sizes of seat cushions and covers over the tattered fabric and worn-out cushioning of the front seats in our 1979 Buick Limited Estate Wagon, my wife Rita convinced me to spend some of the kid's inheritance and have them professionally reupholstered. Because the wagon is often used on long trips towing our Airstream Argosy camper, comfort was a main consideration. And because the wagon is in otherwise such great original condition, we decided that doing them back to original design with correct material was also a must. Finding a local upholsterer to do the work wasn't easy. One shop who has done work for me since the 1960's looked at the double cushioned seats and said "Nope, not touching them, those cushions are the most tedious and aggravating thing I've ever done, I'm too old for the hassle". I finally found a shop who is well known in the area for doing excellent custom work and who was very reasonably priced. Luke Golden of Golden Upholstery in Athens, GA 404 931 9673

I Obtained the correct name and number for Tan Striped Velour Cloth material from the 1979 Buick



I Requested pricing and ordered the materials from SMS Auto Fabrics, the only supplier known to have correct original cloth seat material for this vehicle

The two different materials arrived approximately 3 weeks after being ordered. Note the date of 10-78 stamped on the back of the material.







The finished product. I think they turned out beautifully. I could not discern any difference from the originals! Luke said the double cushions were indeed tedious and he spent some 3 ½ days on the job. He also added additional special foam padding per Rita's instruction. Note the rear seats are vinyl as could be special ordered as Tan Cloth Front – Vinyl Rear commonly referred to as childproofing.


